

Skate 360 terms & conditions

By using the Skate360 roller rink, all participants understand and accept the following terms and conditions and agree to comply with the rules set out:

1. You understand that roller skating/blading can be a dangerous activity, accidents such as but not limited to falls, trips, collisions with other participants and permanent structures are very possible. These accidents can lead to personal injury, damage to your property and in worst case death.
2. Brighton i360 Limited will not be held responsible for the loss or theft of personal property.
3. Personal items should not be left unattended anywhere on site. Unattended items will be removed and destroyed.
4. You will follow verbal instructions from the Skate 360 team and comply with the written notices where appropriate.
5. You agree that you may be subject to a security search prior to entry on to the Skate360 area.
6. There is no eating or drinking whilst on the rink.
7. Smoking is prohibited throughout the Skate360 area.
8. All children under the age of 12 must always be accompanied by an adult 18+. Children aged 5-8 must be accompanied at a ratio of 1:6, children aged 9-11 must be accompanied at a ratio of 1:8. Children under the age of 5 are not permitted on the rink.
9. You agree to wear suitable clothing whilst skating, this will include socks, no long or excessively baggy items, we also politely request that all participants wear a top.
10. Helmets are strongly advised but not mandatory, the choice to not use a helmet is up to the individual however no claims of injury can be made for refusal to wear one.
11. Failure to adhere to the terms and conditions stated above and any instruction given whilst on site can result in your removal from the premises.
12. By using the rink, you accept the risks detailed above and by doing so you release and discharge the Brighton i360 including its directors and staff from any claims involving injury, death or damage/loss of personal items.
13. Participants wishing to use their own skates or blades need to have their skates/blades inspected by rink staff. Skates/blades must have jam breaks intact. Rink staff have the right to refuse use of participants skates/blades.
